

## Beryl

Other than Emerald and Aquamarine, most of the beryl on the market today is pink (Morganite) or Golden. Beryl is typically inclusion free, except the Emeralds, of course.

What does it say about you if you wear Beryl? People drawn to Beryl are thought to want to focus, and have strong insights. You want to set your priorities, and channel your energy into what will have the greatest impact.

Beryl is most often found in Afghanistan, Brazil, China, Madagascar, Africa, and even the US! Morganite, pink Beryl was named after J.P. Morgan the famous banker and collector.

Beryl is a wearable gem with a Moh's hardness rating of 7.5 – 8. The refractive Index of Beryl is 1.564 – 1.596. This is a wider range of refraction than in many doubly refractive stones. When I look at Beryl, It seems I can see the light bending more, and moving more than in some gems.
